



Supporting children to complete the 'impossible mission': Pre-Radiotherapy Education Workshop

Department of Health Technology and Informatics (HTI), a partner of CCF in conducting educational workshops to prepare children cancer patients for radiotherapy. The project was set up in April 2021. CCF Child Life Specialists, HTI professors and students, together they design and conduct the workshops for patients and carers.



Empowering Children: Utilizing Immersive Reality for Paediatric Radiotherapy

The dedicated radiotherapy (RT) team at PolyU, consisting academic faculty, senior RT students, and experienced radiation therapists, will showcase their innovative use of immersive reality within a six-sided Cave Automatic Virtual Environment (CAVE). This demonstration will focus on preparing a four-year-old pediatric patient for radiation therapy, highlighting the transformative role of immersive reality to empower both patient and caregivers in coping with RT.

Comforting Injured Children with Outline Dolls

It was a typical day when the Child Life Specialist concluded a session in the children's ward when an unexpected call came. The victims of a massive traffic accident, a group of primary school students, had been ushered in and urgently needed support.

Amid the chaotic scene, the Specialist found two anxious sisters and gave them an outline doll, which they quickly named Cici. As they began to coloured Cici, reflecting their own perceived injuries, their anxiety eased. The younger sister played nurse, tending to Cici's wounds while the older sister carefully rendered them.

Nearby, two boys, Tse and Wong, sat in their sports gear, seemingly undeterred by the surrounding medical chaos. As the Specialist engaged them, they narrated the accident as an adventure while decorating the doll Dai Ming, Though hurt, their friendship remained strong as they discussed future ball games.

The outline dolls helped the children articulate and process their fears. They were colouring and distracted from their pain, showing how such therapeutic tools assist hospitalized children needing both physical and mental support. Our Child Life Specialists brought hope, empowering the injured children through creative play during difficult times.
